## Nicholas Wheeler Vivian

Our guest speaker, Wheeler Vivian, shared with us the story behind the Nicholas Wheeler Vivian Foundation which provides funding to families in need for medical services for their children. On April 16, 2005, Katherine and Wheeler Vivian's lives changed forever. Their triplet babies Noah, 1 lb. 8 oz, Nicholas 1 lb. 14 oz, and Savannah 1 lb. 10 oz, arrived four months premature. They felt helpless watching the babies struggling for each breath, fighting to stay alive. Tragically, Nicholas passed away after several months. In his memory, they started the foundation to raise funds to assist families in need.

Wheeler shared photos of all the children at birth and the marvelous photos of Noah and Savannah today. While Noah will continue to need medications for at least several more years, Savannah is medicine free at this point. Both of the surviving triplets are wonderful active children today.


