Thanks to Phyllis for bringing Molly McDonough, to talk with us tonight. Molly recently visited Haiti with a group from Church of the Holy Family, Chapel Hill. Holy Family helps to support the schools in Haiti operated by Pere (father) Noe. Molly is the daughter of Linda McDonough who recently spoke with us about her school in Durham, Just Right Academy.

When the group arrived, they spent a short time in Cap Haitian, then began the 6+ hour drive into the mountains over a very rough road. Molly became

ill on this portion of the trip and had to wait at the bottom of the mountain while the others hiked 5 miles up the steep slope. Pere Noe's school and church are near the mountain top. Some of the students came down to help Molly to the top.

Some of the children walk for several hours each day to come to school. They even carried some beds from their homes, so that their guests would not have sleep on the ground.

All of the group's luggage and the school supplies being donated were carried up the mountain by the students and school staff. The children have lunch at this school as a result of profits from the sale of soup mix from a project Molly started in Chapel Hill. The soup mix sells for \$5 per bag. One dollar goes toward buying ingredients for the next batch and \$4 is donated to the school lunch program.
